As DU stands firm, no end to impasse on Stephen's entries

NEW DELHI: Amid an ongoing tussle between Delhi University (DU) and St Stephen's College over conducting interviews for admissions, DU officials on Friday said that the varsity is firm on its decision that admissions for unreserved seats should be solely based on the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) scores.

DU registrar Vikas Gupta said that the varsity will write to the college on Monday and maintained that the university will not accept admissions conducted in violation of its admission policy.

"We will write to the college on Monday and inform them that it needs to follow the admission process of the university. Our stand is the same as before. Admission to unreserved seats needs to be done through CUET scores alone. There will be no interview component for general seats. Admission in violation of DU's policy will not be accepted," said Gupta.

An elusive common ground

THE ISSUE
Delhi University and St Stephen's College have been at loggerheads over the new admission policy. While DU's 2022-23 admission policy seeks doing away with interviews and relying on CUET scores for 50% unreserved seats, St Stephen's insists on giving 15% weightage to interviews for all admissions. The college insists it is allowed to set its own admission criteria since it is a minority college. DU, however, warned it will declare the admissions 'null and void'.

BACK AND FORTH

March 22: DU's academic council passes a proposal making CUET score the sole criteria for UG admissions in all colleges.

March 31: DU vice chancellor Yogesh Singh confirms receiving a request from St Stephen's to continue with the practice of holding interviews for UG admissions, giving it 15% weightage.

April 5: DU releases 2022-23 admission policy, under which admissions to 50% unreserved seats will only be on the basis of the CUET score. Admission to the reserved seats will require 85% weightage to CUET score and 15% weightage for interviews.

April 11: St Stephen's College sticks to its ground, notifies that 15% weightage will be for interviews in all admissions.

April 16: DU asks college to comply with admission policy, seeks response by April 19.

April 20: St Stephen's college writes to DU, asking it has the right to proceed with admissions as per its own admission policy as a minority institution.

May 23: Stephen's releases prospectus, sticks to the 85:15 weightage formula.

May 24: DU warns it will declare "null and void" all admissions made by St Stephen's in violation of the CUET guidelines.

May 26: St Stephen's College requests DU registrar to reconsider the university's position.

May 27: DU, however, stays firm on its decision to annual admissions in violation of its admission policy.

Consider hiking fine on vector breeding to ₹50k: HC to state govt

NEW DELHI: The Delhi high court has asked the Delhi government to explore the possibility of hiking the fine for every violation that leads to mosquito breeding from ₹5,000 to ₹50,000.

On May 20, a bench of acting chief justice Vipin Sanghi and justice Jasmeet Singh, while hearing a suo motu plea on the increasing mosquito infestation in the city, also asked authorities to examine the imposition of on-the-spot fines to create deterrence in the minds of the people who allow mosquito breeding on their premises.

The court observed that the efficacy of the system of imposing fines as a deterrent will be lost if fines are not imposed on the spot.

"In our view, the Delhi government should seriously examine the proposal for imposition of fines — on the spot, if deterrence has to be created in the minds of the people to not allow mosquito breeding in their premises. We are also of the view that where institutions are found guilty of such conduct, the quantum of fine should not be limited to merely ₹5,000, and should be fixed at ₹50,000. The GNCTD (Delhi government) level and respond on the next

date," said the bench in its order.

Agreeing with the suggestion of the amicus curiae that the efficacy of the system of imposition of fines as a deterrent would be completely lost, if fines are not imposed on the spot, the court also said, "...we entirely agree with him... We may also notice that mere chalking the violators and those found guilty of allowing mosquito breeding on their premises, would only lead to the explosion of such cases in the courts, adding to the already existing heavy burdens that have to deal with."

The court also directed all local bodies, authorities, and departments to strictly comply with and fulfill their respective obligations in terms of the common protocol evolved for the prevention and control of vector-borne diseases.

"They shall remain bound by the said common protocol. Failure to comply with the same, and lapses in implementation of the common protocol shall be viewed seriously, and the chief executive officers of the other local bodies/ authorities shall be personally held liable for the same," it said.

100K TAKE TRIPS ON DELHI E-BUSES IN 3 DAYS SINCE LAUNCH

NEW DELHI: Around 100,000 commuters hopped on to Delhi's electric buses between Tuesday and Friday, the three days when trips on the newly launched vehicles were free, said state government officials aware of the matter.

As Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal flagged off 150 e-buses on May 24, the state government announced free travel on these vehicles for three days, in a bid to promote clean mobility.

MLAs, along with the top brass of Delhi's transport department, took three days to review the facilities as well.

State transport minister Kailash Ghalot said of the 100,000 passengers, 40% were women.

"About 12,000 people travelled on the first day (May 24). About 28,000 people travelled the next day, and about 52,000 took trips on e-buses on May 26," Ghalot said.

Govt axes projects to strengthen 16 key roads

Meanwhile, the state government on Friday also approved projects worth over ₹16 crore to strengthen 16 key roads in the city, including one in front of the Akshardham Temple and Metro station, to ease travel between Noida and Delhi.

The projects were approved by deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia, who also holds the state Public Works Department portfolio, mtc

Doorstep vax drive restarted in bid to cover all residents

NEW DELHI: To ensure full coverage of the two-set Covid-19 vaccinations before moving on to the precautionary doses, the Delhi government has restarted a door-to-door campaign to identify people who are yet to get their first and second doses and bring them under the vaccination net, senior government officials said on Friday.

Senior officials of the Delhi government's health department said that while the city has recorded 100% coverage of the first vaccine dose, around 10-15% of the eligible population were yet to take their second dose.

"We have started training our Aasha and Anganwadi workers, along with our teams at the district levels, so that they can pay door-to-door visits to make a list of the people who are yet to get their first and second Covid doses. We want to take into account that there would still be people who are not part of the city's registered population list and might not have received even their first vaccine shot," said a senior health official, asking not to be named.

Officials said the provision of

at-home vaccination will be made available for senior citizens and the differently abled, and special camps will be set up near residential areas for others. The drive will continue till June end, after which the administration will again carry out an assessment.

Currently, vaccinations are available for those above 12 years of age in the Capital.

Data from the government's CoWin dashboard shows that Delhi so far has administered 18,045,535 first doses of Covid and 15,050,327 second doses. Around 1,087,131 people in the Capital have also received their booster doses, according to government data.

HC restrains website from using HT Media Limited domain name

NEW DELHI: The Delhi high court has restrained a rogue website from using a deceptively similar domain as that of Hindustan Times (HT), saying the former intends to encroach on the goodwill of HT Media Limited.

On May 24, Justice Prathiba M Singh restrained the use of www.hindustantimes.tech, comprising the words "Hindustan Times" till the next date of hearing (September 22), after HT Media moved court seeking directions to stop the website from using their copyrighted name.

Granting ex-parte relief to HT, the court also restrained the owners of the website www.hindustantimes.tech from publishing any content, including articles, stories, columns, reviews, etc. in violation of HT Media's copyright.

HT Media Limited, in its plea, contended that the rogue website offered services identical to those offered by HT Media.

It alleged that the said website was also engaged in reproducing, publishing, and making available news, articles, stories and columns created and published by the plaintiffs (HT Media Limited) on their website (www.hindustantimes.com). Saying that the plaintiffs (HT

Media Limited) made out a prima facie case for the grant of an ex-parte interim injunction in their favour, the court said that irreparable loss and injury would be caused to the plaintiffs if the injunction was not granted in their favour.

"Hindustan Times" is the registered trademark of the plaintiffs. The plaintiffs command a global viewership and the reputation of one of India's oldest newspapers. The manner in which the mark name "Hindustan Times" has been completely misappropriated leaves no manner of doubt in the mind of the court that defendant number one intends to misuse the said mark as also the content which is published by the plaintiffs (HT Media Limited) on their website," the judge said in the order dated May 24.

The court granted 30 days to the defendants to reply to the summons.

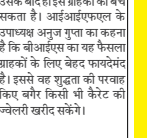

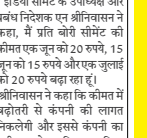
