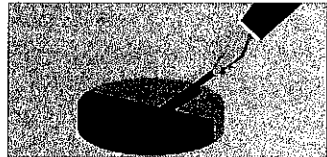

14 extensions later, panel on OBC sub-quotas files report

It's Now Govt's Call On Quota System Rejj

New Delhi: After almost six years and 14 extensions, the commission for sub-categorisation of OBCs submitted its report on the last day of its tenure on Monday, putting the ball in the court of the Modi government to decide if it wants to redraft the current structure for the backward classes created by the Mandal Commission. The Rajiv Commission submitted the report to the President in an official release said. The recommendations of the commission are still to be known officially, though there is speculation about it.



The Rajiv commission was set up in October 2017.

The panel, headed by retired Justice B.R. Laxmi, was to initially submit its report in 12 weeks, but has since been given 14 extensions. The BJP had developed conflict over the subject, after a row in December 2018 assembly elections among the various OBC communities. The complaint has been that stronger castes, with good economic and educational standards, and consequently better employment opportunities, have been overlooking the quota benefits at the cost of weaker castes. The sub-grouping, with each bloc eligible for only a portion of 27% quota, is said to provide a fair distribution of affirmative action. Many believe that the strategy lies in with the BJP's attempt to woo the "most backward".

'Kavach' system deployed in just 20 km in 2022-23

Indian Railways deployed 'Kavach', the indigenously developed automatic train protection system, on only 20 km in 2022-23. The railway ministry said in reply to a question raised in Rajya Sabha on Monday. In the past five years, the railways deployed this system on 1,455 km and 121 locomotives on the Eastern Central Railway network.

Speaking on the occasion of PDP's 25th foundation day, Paray said most of the parties and leaders in J&K were planning to hold elections only for getting official honours and security cover. NC's chief spokesperson Imran Nabi Dar retorted that Paray's intention, he said, was to sow confusion among the opposition ranks.
