

Gail Profit Jumps 11x to ₹2,843 cr

New Delhi: Gail's December-quarter profit jumped 11 times from a year ago to ₹2,843 crore, helped by increased supply and lower cost of imported natural gas. The earnings boosted Gail's shares, which closed 3.8% higher on the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE) on Monday. India's largest natural gas transporter and marketer had repor-



ted a profit of ₹246 crore in the year-ago quarter.

For the quarter, the company has reported a 3% year-on-year decline in revenue to ₹35,065 crore on lower prices.

"During the quarter, the physical performance has improved across all major business verticals and the petrochemical segment has turned profitable owing to plant efficiency, better capacity utilisation and other optimisation measures," said Sandeep Kumar Gupta, chairman and managing director of Gail. The operating profit from the natural gas transmission business nearly tripled to ₹1,215 crore. – Our Bureau

GAIL Q3 profit rises multifold to ₹3,193 crore on cheaper LNG

State-run GAIL (India) on Monday reported a multi-fold jump in its consolidated net profit for the quarter ended December at ₹3,193.34 crore, buoyed by a fall in international prices of liquefied natural gas (LNG) and increase in transmission tariff.

During the same period of the last fiscal year, the company had reported a net profit of ₹397.59 crore. Higher gas trading margins also bolstered profits of the state-run gas utility, which imports LNG and supplies to consumers through pipelines. On Monday, GAIL



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(India) said it has concluded a long-term pact to buy around 0.5 million metric tonne per annum LNG from UAE's ADNOC Gas.

The Delhi-based company's total income, however, fell

3.31% on year to ₹35,181.78 crore in the quarter ended December, it said in a statement.

Amid a fall in gas prices, its total expenditure during the October-December quarter stood at ₹31,607.96 crore, nearly 13% lower than in the same period last year.

GAIL inks gas deal with Adnoc

News Delhi: Gas utility GAIL on Monday signed an agreement with UAE's national oil company Adnoc for sourcing half a million tonne of liquefied natural gas annually, marking the state-run utility's second term deal this month to tie up total supplies valued at about \$7 billion. Adnoc will start supplies from 2026 for 10 years. On January 5, GAIL had tied up a 10-year LNG supply deal of one million tonne annually with Dutch trader Vitol. TNN

GAIL inks LNG import deal with UAE's ADNOC

NEW DELHI: India's biggest gas firm GAIL on Monday said it has signed an agreement to buy 0.5 million tonne per annum of LNG from UAE's ADNOC-Gas, the second supply deal it has stitched this month as part of shoring up supplies to meet energy demands of the country.

"This is pursuant to an MoU dated October 30, 2022, between GAIL and Abu Dhabi National Oil Company (ADNOC)" wherein the two had addressed to "explore opportunities, including the purchase of LNG by GAIL from ADNOC for a tenure ranging from short term to medium and long-term", the company said in a statement.

Under this agreement, the deliveries will commence from 2026 onwards for a duration of 10 years, across India. It did not disclose pricing and other details.

"This arrangement is believed to further aid in India's rising energy security requirements and, simultaneously, also fuel GAIL's strategic growth objectives to cater to its downstream customers in the rapidly



evolving natural gas landscape of the country," it said.

On January 5, GAIL announced the signing of a deal to import 1 million tonnes of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from Dutch energy trader Vitol for 10 years, starting in 2026.

GAIL chairman and managing director Sandeep Kumar Gupta said this long-term LNG deal with ADNOC will contribute to bridging the gap in India's demand and supply of natural gas and will open more avenues of strategic partnership between the two firms in other areas of the energy domain.

Underlining the broader impact of the agreement, GAIL

Director (Marketing) Sanjay Kumar said this long-term LNG transaction by GAIL will help India in moving towards the Government of India's objective of enhancing the share of natural gas in India's energy basket to 15 per cent by 2030 from current 6.2 per cent.

Further, this deal will also help GAIL to augment its significantly large LNG portfolio to serve its diverse consumer profile.

GAIL will import LNG in cryogenic ships and turn it back into its gaseous state before piping it to users that may include power plants for generating electricity, fertilizer units for

producing crop nutrients or city gas operators for selling to automobiles as CNG or piping to household kitchens for cooking.

India imports roughly half of its gas needs as local production is insufficient to meet demand.

GAIL operates a 5 million tonnes a year LNG import facility at Dabhol in Maharashtra and has leased space at terminals in Gujarat and Odisha. It is scouting for a 26 per cent stake in a US-based LNG plant to source 1 million tonnes-a-year of LNG for 15 years.

These volumes were to make up for a shortfall in supplies in a Russian contract as well as to meet increased demand.

In 2012, GAIL signed a 20-year deal with GMTS to buy an annual average of 2.5 million tonnes of LNG. GMTS was a unit of Gazprom Germania, now called Sefe. The Russian parent gave up ownership of Sefe after Western sanctions over Russia's invasion of Ukraine.

Sefe halted supply to GAIL in May 2022 and resumed only a year later.

State-run gas supplier Gail (India) on Monday reported a 703 per cent rise in consolidated net profit at ₹3,193 crore in the third quarter (October-December) of 2023-24 (FY24) against ₹397.6 crore in the year-ago period. Sequentially, its net profit rose 30.75 per cent, up from ₹2,442.18 crore.

The latest rise in net profits came on a low base as Gail had suffered from disruptions to supply from Russian energy giant Gazprom and higher global gas prices. The growth was accompanied by a 3.26 per cent fall in consolidated revenue from operations to ₹34,767.8 crore in Q3FY24, down from ₹35,939.9 crore in Q3FY23. नई दिल्ली, (भाषा)। सार्वजनिक क्षेत्र की गैस कंपनी गेल इंडिया लिमिटेड का चालू वित्त वर्ष की दिसंबर तिमाही में एकल आधार पर शुद्ध लाभ 10 गुना उछलकर 2,842.62 करोड़ रुपये हो गया। गेल इंडिया ने सोमवार को शेयर बाजारों को दी गई सूचना में कहा कि गैस परिवहन से लेकर पेट्रोरसायन तक सभी कारोबार क्षेत्रों के अच्छे प्रदर्शन से उसके शुद्ध लाभ में जोरदार बढ़ोतरी हुई है। एक साल पहले की समान तिमाही में कंपनी का शुद्ध लाभ 245.73 करोड़ रुपये था। वहीं जुलाई-सितंबर, 2023 की तिमाही में इसका लाभ 2,404.89 करोड़ रुपये था। हालांकि अक्टूबर-दिसंबर, 2023 की तिमाही में कंपनी का परिचालन राजस्व 34,253.52 करोड़ रुपये पर लगभग स्थिर बना रहा। चालू वित्त वर्ष के पहले नौ महीनों में गेल इंडिया का शुद्ध लाभ 42 प्रतिशत बढ़कर 6,659.51 करोड़ रुपये हो गया जबकि इसका राजस्व 98,303.61 करोड़ रुपये रहा। गेल के चेयरमैन एवं प्रबंध निदेशक संदीप कुमार गुप्ता ने कहा कि आलोच्य तिमाही में सभी प्रमुख कारोबार खंडों में प्रदर्शन बेहतर रहा है। इस दौरान पेट्रोरसायन खंड भी लाभ की स्थिति में पहुंच गया। उन्होंने कहा कि गेल ने अप्रैल-दिसंबर की अवधि में पाइपलाइन, पेट्रोरसायन और संयुक्त उद्यमों को इट्रिटी अंशदान पर 6,583 करोड़ रुपये का पूंजीगत व्यय किया है।
